Readathon

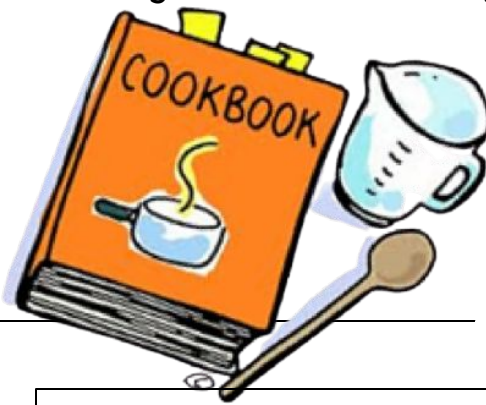
H.G. Blake will be holding its first Readathon this November, and we are very excited to introduce this fundraiser to our school!

Please help stop the spread of COVID-19 by completing the Daily Symptom Check with your child(ren) before sending them to school each day.

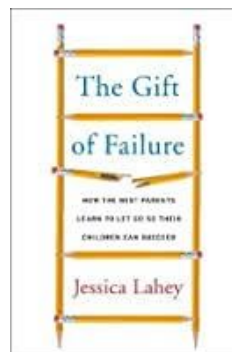

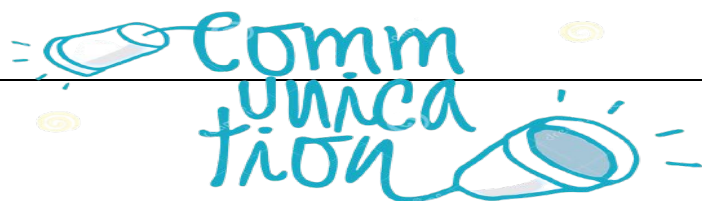
